

# MILLENNIUM DEVELOPMENT GOALS UKRAINE: 2000-2015



## REDUCE POVERTY

**3.5%** OF UKRAINIANS ARE CONSIDERED POOR BY THE ABSOLUTE POVERTY RATE. IN 2000 THIS WAS **11.9%** (PEOPLE WHO LIVE ON LESS THEN US\$5 PER DAY BY PURCHASING POWER PARITY)

SINCE 2000, **POVERTY** BY ACTUAL SUBSISTENCE MINIMUM HAS BEEN **REDUCED** FROM **71%** IN 2000 TO **30%**

ABOUT **ONE QUARTER OF UKRAINIANS** LIVE AT OR **BELOW** THE NATIONAL POVERTY LINE

EVERY **THIRD** FAMILY WITH CHILDREN IS POOR  
EVERY **FIFTH** WORKING PERSON IS POOR

## ENSURE QUALITY LIFELONG EDUCATION

**99.6%** OF CHILDREN OF SECONDARY-SCHOOL AGE ARE ENROLLED IN **FULL-TIME EDUCATION**

**INTERNET** IS AVAILABLE MORE THAN **80%** OF SCHOOLS



**HALF** OF YOUNG PEOPLE ARE ENROLLED IN **HIGHER EDUCATION**



IN 2015, **47** WOMEN AMONG **422** MEMBERS OF THE UKRAINIAN PARLIAMENT (**11%**)

THE AVERAGE WAGE GAP BETWEEN MEN AND WOMEN IS **23%**

## REDUCE CHILD MORTALITY

BETWEEN **1995** AND **2015** THE **CHILD MORTALITY RATE** (UP TO ONE YEAR OF AGE) ALMOST **HALVED**, **14.7** DROPPING FROM TO **7.8** DEATHS PER 1000 LIVE BIRTHS

THE **MORTALITY RATE** AMONG CHILDREN OF UP TO FIVE YEARS OF AGE **DECREASED** FROM **16.0** IN 2000 TO **9.3**

BETWEEN **2000** AND **2015** THE **MATERNAL MORTALITY** RATE IN UKRAINE **DECREASED** FROM **24.7** TO **15.2** DEATHS PER 100,000 LIVE BIRTHS

## IMPROVE MATERNAL HEALTH

**40%** OF UKRAINE'S ADULT POPULATION (INCLUDING WOMEN OF REPRODUCTIVE AGE) HAS AT LEAST **ONE CHRONIC DISEASE**

**90%** OF WOMEN UNDERGO **REGULAR MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS** IN EARLY STAGES OF PREGNANCY

## REDUCE AND SLOW DOWN THE SPREAD OF HIV/AIDS AND TUBERCULOSIS AND INITIATE A TREND TO DECREASE THEIR SCALES



THERE ARE **264,000** HIV-POSITIVE PEOPLE IN UKRAINE

THE INCIDENCE OF TUBERCULOSIS HAD DECREASED BY **25%** COMPARED TO 2005 FROM **84** TO **60** CASES PER 100,000 POPULATION

THE MOTHER-TO-CHILD HIV TRANSMISSION RATE **FELL** FROM **27.8%** IN 2001 TO **4.3%**

DUE TO HUMAN ACTIVITY, ABOUT **70%** OF SURFACE WATER AND A LARGE SHARE OF THE GROUNDWATER RESOURCES **ARE NO LONGER A SOURCE OF SAFE DRINKING WATER**

**4.0** MILLION TONNES OF POLLUTANTS ANNUALLY WERE RELEASED INTO THE AIR IN UKRAINE

**2.0** MILLION TONNES OF EMISSIONS ARE FROM **TRANSPORTATION AND PRODUCTION** **90.5%** ARE EMISSIONS FROM AUTOMOBILES
